



- ... that the longest tunnel under the ocean is between the island of Hokkaido and Honshu in Japan. It is 22 miles long.

At home . . . and at school:


Kelly is playing at her home in California with her BRIO trains. Kelly is three years old and her favorite train cars are the caboose and locomotive.




The 'longest' railway.



There is a 297 mile stretch of straight track in Australia. It goes across the Nullarbor Plain where there are no trees. It is part of the transcontinental railway that is 2,461 miles long between Perth and Sydney. Can you find these cities along the way: Melbourne, Adelaide?








The 'longest' railway bridge.
